LEAVING FOR BREAK CHECKLIST



Be sure to take care of
ALL these items BEFORE
you leave your room.

- ☐ Pick up your room.
- ☐ Clean out your refrigerator and throw away food that will perish before you return.
- ☐ Take all trash to dumpsters so it doesn't attract pests.
- ☐ Unplug electrical appliances — excludes refrigerators and aquariums with lights and heaters (don't forget the fish food!).
- ☐ Take home pet fish in small bowls (not in aquariums).
- ☐ Close and lock windows.
- ☐ Close blinds.
- ☐ Look over room one more time — ensure that it is presentable AND clean.
- ☐ Turn off all lights.
- ☐ Lock the door as you leave.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

- ♦ **All campus dining locations are CLOSED during break.**
- ♦ **SSC hours during break** — see web calendar & posted signs
- ♦ **Staying over break** — Students who have a legitimate need to stay in the halls over the break period must submit the Request to Stay Over Break Form to the Office of Housing & Residence Life (Cantrell Hall) by Wednesday, Mar. 6 @ noon. For non-college business, there is a per-day charge. There is no charge for official-college business; signature of your coach/supervisor is required on the form. The form is available in both the Housing Office and on-line at www.uvawise.edu/reslife.
- ♦ **Planning & packing** — Carefully consider what you need to take with you during the break period as you cannot return to the halls until Sunday, Mar. 17 @ 9 am. Take all valuables, homework, electronics & chargers, work uniforms, medications, special occasion attire, hunting clothing, etc. — anything you might want to use during this time away from your res hall room.
